Celia’s House recommends masks for any resident who is comfortable wearing one as an added precaution.</p> <p>Must wear a mask at all times in resident care areas and practice social distancing.</p>
<p>Building Access & Screening</p>	<p>All</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Access to Celia’s House is restricted to the main entrance – through a screening checkpoint. All those entering will be assessed for possible COVID exposure and will receive a temperature check. • All common areas of Celia’s House are closed. • Anyone with symptoms of illness will generally not be allowed entry. A consultation with our Executive Administrator or administrator-on-call may provide options. • Those with known exposure risks will work with Executive Administrator or designee administrator-on-call to determine visitation protocols.
<p>Communication</p>	<p>Resident Families & Visitors</p>	<p>Families and Visitors may call during business hours to receive updates on COVID-related information pertaining to Celia’s House and visitations.</p> <p>Important updates will also be sent by email to families of current residents.</p>
<p>Visits for Residents</p> <p><i>The State of Oregon allows for compassionate visitation for hospice patients, even as other facilities have greater COVID-19 restrictions. Check with the Executive Administrator or administrator-on-call for an end-of-life visitation plan.</i></p>	<p>Visitors</p>	<p>In-Person Visits:</p> <p>Must wear a mask at all times in resident care areas and practice social distancing as much as possible.</p> <p>Must limit movements inside Celia’s House to their resident’s room, entry and exit pathways and garden areas. Please, no entry into common areas of the home.</p> <p>Virtual Visits:</p> <p>Staff can assist family to conduct virtual visits with the use of iPads in resident rooms. Please request via email at: info@sofriendsofhospice.org, or call, to schedule.</p> <p>Added Safety Measures for In-Person Visits:</p> <p>If Visitor has COVID – Entry is not allowed. Following a COVID positive test, quarantine is required for a minimum of 14 days. To regain house entry, additional criteria related to symptoms may be required beyond follow-up negative test results. You will be asked to provide a medical clearance to administrative staff for re-entry privileges. Consult with our Executive Administrator or designee administrator-on-call.</p>
