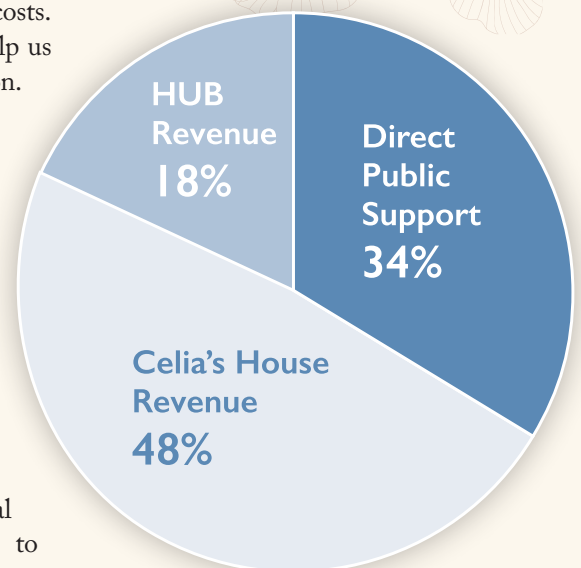

With guidance and support of our entire community, I am struck by the number of hurdles our organization surmounted! Even with COVID operational and financial impacts, and key personnel changes, Southern Oregon Friends of Hospice, Celia's House and The HUB, have accomplished great things during a very complex time.

Throughout the year, we were presented with daily pandemic response duties. Complying with changing state and federal mandates raised our daily operating costs and challenged the vital "Mindful Caregiving" environment that is a hallmark of Celia's House. To keep everyone safe, visitor restrictions impeded our wonderful volunteers' ability to be with our residents at the bedside. Masks, gowns and face shields in place, we still found unique ways to support our residents, families, caregiving staff and volunteers, keeping hearts focused on quality end-of-life care and experiences.

In October, we were excited to announce our new Executive Director, Dwight Wilson, RN, MN. Dwight brings over 30 years of hospice leadership to his position and we are grateful for his experience and vision.

We are thankful to our many community donors who helped us meet rising costs during our Volunteers & Friends fundraising appeal. The subsequent generosity of Jed & Celia Meese allowed us to pay off the Celia's House mortgage—a

monumental gift that now saves us \$6,330 in monthly payments! A second government "Payroll Protection Plan" loan helped us retain and pay all our employees during the darkest pandemic days.

With our emphasis on inclusion, residents who qualify are now financially benefitting from assistance agreements with Asante, Providence, Medicaid, and (most recently) the Veterans Administration. In partnership with the Oregon Community Foundation and through the contributions of visionary donors, we have established an endowment fund to build long-term sustainability. Our HUB retail store continues to shine brightly; and, with the aid of vaccinations, our volunteers are now returning to Celia's House, bringing joy to residents and staff alike.

I look forward to another year of accomplishments under the steady leadership of incoming Board Chair, Norman Fincher. As a long-term, successful investment advisor, Norman has provided
