Rituals can help the grieving and healing process after the death of a loved one. We understand this is not an easy time for you or your family. These rituals are completely optional. They are offered in support of those who have traditions or approaches to grieving that might find solace in these practices. We will honor your preferences with the greatest respect.

After Death

- We offer the ritual washing of the body, either just the face and hands or the whole body.
- We can anoint the feet, hands, and/or forehead with oil.
- If you would like extended time with the deceased to say goodbye, please make arrangements with the administrator.

This is an opportunity for those present at the time of death—family, friends, and Celia’s House staff—to pause, acknowledge the power of the moment, and honor the life of the resident as the deceased departs from Celia’s House.
